- 3. encourage partnership, dialogue and cooperation focused on solving the problems (not only) of fish migration;
- 4. get an overview of commitments and international context of the fish migration and wetland restoration;
- 5. introduce successful flow revitalization projects and fish migration protection;
- 6. open up the issue of utilization of hydropower potential of watercourses and possible solutions;
- 7. stimulate the discussion and cooperation between the institutions in the joint assessment of aquatic ecosystems, restoration and removal of barriers on the rivers.
